How do I become a volunteer?

To register for a volunteer opportunity, please visit our [Get Connected profile](#) and sign up/login. Once you are logged in you will be able to view all of volunteer opportunities at the Festival of Trees. Once you find an opportunity you are interested, simply sign up for that activity/shift.

Will I have to stand or walk for long periods of time?

Some volunteer opportunities require light/heavy lifting, carrying, bending, standing, and walking. The physical requirements will be noted in the description of the volunteer opportunity on Get Connected.

If you do not wish to stand or walk for long periods of time some suggested volunteer opportunities are: Pre-Festival Help, Entertainment Check-In Room Attendant, Ticket Taker.

What is the time commitment required to volunteer?

The volunteer shifts at the Festival of Trees range from 2-5 hours long depending on the volunteer opportunity.

What should I wear?

Please wear shoes that will be kind to your feet throughout your busy day.

Dress comfortably, casually, and appropriately for the event (no torn or low riding jeans/pants and no exposed midriffs). You will be supplied with a Festival of Trees apron to wear during your volunteer shift.

Where should I park at the Mayo Civic Center?

Ample parking is available downtown. Use the Civic Theater entrance on the corner of Civic Center Drive and East Center Street OR the Skyway from the Mayo Civic Center ramp.

Will a meal be provided?

No, a meal will not be provided but volunteers can enjoy cookies, cocoa, coffee, and water at the Holiday Café.
