Mission

To provide quality support services to people with disabilities at home and in the community.

Purpose: The Basic Program Needs Volunteer at Hiawatha Homes will work with staff to help provide support services to people with disabilities at their home.

Location: The Basic Program Needs Volunteer will work within a designated residential-based program located within the Rochester, Minnesota community.

Report to: Hiawatha Homes Foundation – Development Associate

Duration: Volunteers can serve any number of hours. We recommend a minimum of 4 hours a month.

Duties:

- Assists staff with light cleaning, meal prep, and/or on-site laundry duties as needed.
- Shop/grocery pick-up and delivery.
- Play games, read books, assist with craft projects, assist electronics, share musical talents, go for walks, etc.
- Administration duties as needed
- Other light duties as needed

Requirements:

- Must be at least 17 years of age.
- Must complete a volunteer application and background check before volunteering.
- Must sign a confidentiality statement.
- Must be willing to work within guidelines, policies, standards, and mission statement of Hiawatha Homes.
- Ability to work in a team environment and accept guidance and direction from staff members.
- Must have reliable transportation to volunteer locations.

Hiawatha Homes will provide the location's address once the above requirements are completed and assist with the first hour on-site to help the volunteer gain familiarity with duties.
